URGENT: OPT YOUR KIDS OUT TODAY from the Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS)!

Paper forms came in the mail last week as a “*passive parental permission form*” meaning **unless** you opt-out, your children WILL participate. To opt out you have to **sign a paper form and return it to the Student Services Office NO LATER THAN TOMORROW, Oct 20th.**

Needless to say, it wasn't delivered to many families until Thursday, Oct 14th. This is the school district actively coercing your children to do something unless you take action to prevent it. And furthermore, making it as difficult as possible for you to do so.

Why your kids should NOT complete the Youth Risk Behavior Survey? It is a tool for the school district and DPI to justify overreach into the care of our children, into the ever increasing move away from academic excellence and into social engineering in our schools.

The data from the 2019 YRBS is a wonderful example of “lying with statistics.” Even a cursory glance at the survey shows some flaws that make most of the information deceiving and meaningless. However, the school, primarily through the office of Dr. “Maggie” Peterson, has used the statistics of the RHS 2019 YRBS to justify the Gender Equity “administrative guidelines” that have been announced through the Northwoods River News on Friday, Oct 8th.
