Natural Immunity vs. Vaccine Immunity - Why doesn't the CDC study this?

In the current push for universal vaccination, not only in our public schools but also in businesses, industry, military, fire and police protection, and even in health care, why aren't we seeing documentation of and support for natural immunity to COVID as an effective option for protection against sickness and death from COVID as well as against transmission of COVID? A Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request submitted by attorney Aaron Siri on behalf of the Informed Consent Action Network (ICAN) asked for "documents reflecting any documented case of an individual who: 1) never received a COVID vaccine; 2) was infected with COVID once, recovered, and then later became infected again; and 3) transmitted SARS-CoV-2 to another person when reinfected." The CDC responded stating: "A search of our records failed to reveal any documents pertaining to your request. The CDC Emergency Operations Center conveyed that this information is not collected." And we should ask, "Why not?" Aside from the fact that the basic science behind vaccines is to trigger the body to produce antibodies, we know that there have been 894,143 [adverse reactions](#) and almost 19,000 deaths from the vaccines. We have peer-reviewed studies that demonstrate that [naturally immune individuals](#) have greater than 95% protection as a result of having had COVID with said immunity not waning while [the vaccine provides much less effective immunity](#) and which wanes rapidly. We also know that studies prove that naturally acquired immunity demonstrates a decreased likelihood of [transmission](#) to others.

Although the CDC released its [study](#) in October in which the agency claimed that vaccination offered greater immunity against COVID as compared to natural immunity, that study has been [criticized](#) for being "highly flawed" by Dr. Marty Makary of Johns Hopkins University, who claims that it "flies in the face of science." In [A](#)

[Review and Autopsy of Two COVID Immunity Studies](#), Martin Kulldorff, Ph.D. (epidemiologist and biostatistician specializing in infectious disease outbreaks and vaccine safety, and senior scientific director of Brownstone Institute) references a [preprint study](#) out of Israel which also contradicts the CDC's findings. Kulldorff states that he has worked on vaccine epidemiology since he joined that Harvard faculty almost two decades ago, and he has "never before seen such a large discrepancy between studies that are supposed to answer the same question." He concluded that the evidence from the Israeli study was solid and that it demonstrated that the COVID-recovered have stronger and longer-lasting immunity against COVID disease than the vaccinated; therefore, there is no reason to prevent them from the activities that are permitted to the vaccinated. In fact, it is [discriminatory](#) to do so.

Due to this information collected from the CDC through the FOIA request, ICAN along with Siri's law firm have threatened to file a lawsuit against the CDC "to redress your actions which are crushing the civil and individual rights of those with natural immunity." It is time to make the science and facts known and to refuse to stand for discrimination based on vaccine status. We need to let our school officials and other government entities know that we don't intend to continue allowing them to force mandates on individuals - especially when there is no science to back up their position that vaccines are the only answer for safe school/work/business/medical environments.
