Spring Primary - Tuesday, February 15, 2022

On Tuesday, February 15, 2022, residents of Rhinelander will be given the opportunity to narrow the field of candidates running for mayor from three to two. Those whose names will be on the ballot are Kris Hanus, Steve Sauer, and Bill Freudenberg. WXPR and the League of Women Voters conducted a forum with the three candidates on February 3rd where they voiced their opinions on multiple topics. There are also runoffs for County Supervisor in Rhinelander District 3, which includes Wards 14, 15, and 16, and in Pelican District 6.


