April 5th General Election Absentee Voting!

The April 5, 2022, Wisconsin General Election will be here soon. It is always best to vote in person, but if you do not plan to vote in person, please give the absentee ballot application your immediate attention.

If you plan to vote “absentee,” now is the time to request your ballot. Instructions for absentee voting can be found [here](#). The attached instructions are clear, but please contact your municipal clerk with any questions, and they will be happy to assist you. The clerks will begin mailing absentee ballots on Tuesday, March 15, 2022.

Absentee voting may be done in person. This starts on Tuesday, March 22, 2022, but you must check with your municipal clerk for the dates and hours they are available (see the above link.)

Remember, the final date to apply for an absentee ballot is Thursday, March 31, 2022.
